LICENCE

This is a limited, non-transferable licence for the use of The Skills Framework for the Information Age and its associated documentation. The SFIA Foundation's General Terms and Conditions form part of this agreement. Licensees should familiarise themselves with those terms and conditions.

By selecting this licence the Licensee agrees to be bound by the terms of this licence, including the terms and conditions set out in The SFIA Foundation's General Terms and Conditions. The Licensee agrees to pay the Foundation, the annual licence fee described in the General Terms and Conditions.

This licence applies to the activities of the Accredited Consultant who is a signatory of the licence. The terms of the licence also apply to a company owned by the Accredited Consultant which exists to purvey the services of the Accredited Consultant alone, and which has no other active employees. The Licensee is permitted to use the term "SFIA Accredited Consultant" and to display the SFIA Accredited Consultant logo in order to promote the licensee's services.
